- Understand and use words relating to position and direction.
- Count in 2s and 10s.
- Recognise and name 3D shapes
- Recognise and understand the value of coins and notes.
- Find half of a shape, a length and a set of objects.

English - Reading & Writing

- Using Language through colour, identify and use verbs and adjectives in writing.
- Predict what will happen next in a story when writing an alternative ending.
- Join in with repeated refrains in We're going on a Bear hunt and We're going on a Lion hunt.
- Discuss the layout of a letter when writing to Santa.
