

## Maths

Count, read, write and order numbers to 20.

Add and subtract within 10.

Identify and name common 2D shapes.

Measure and compare lengths.

Begin to solve word problems involving addition and subtraction.

Find doubles of numbers to 5.

Begin to count in steps of 2.

## English

Use role play to recall and retell the story 'Tyrannosaurus Drip'.

Create and describe a new dinosaur when reading Harry and his bucketful of Dinosaurs.

Look at story structure when creating story maps for our new dinosaur adventure stories.

Extend use of adjectives when describing ourselves and characters within our key stories.

To begin to suggest and use time connectives in story writing.

## Science

Identify and name a variety of common animals and sort them into amphibians, fish, birds, reptiles, mammals and insects.

Describe and compare different features of animals.

Experiment with the ways different animals move.

Explore animals' diets and the terms carnivore, herbivore and omnivore.

Name and identify nocturnal animals.

## History

To develop an awareness of things that happened in the past.

Name different species of dinosaur and discuss their different characteristics.

Discuss why we do not have dinosaurs today and use the term extinction.

Look at fossils and how they are made.

Discuss famous historical figures such as Mary Anning when learning about fossils.

## RE

Understand that Christians believe in God and follow the example of Jesus.

Retell stories that show what Christians might think about God, in words, drama and pictures..

Participate in Art week alongside College and explore environmental art.

Work together to make salt dough to create fossils.
